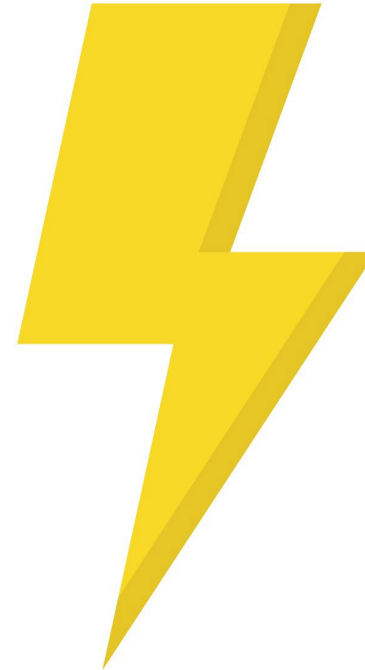

- Often integrated with water recycling – brings water consumption from around 20-30 L/kg to 6-10 L/kg
